The SAKK Coordinating Center is seeking two full-time (80-100%) biostatisticians to start working as soon as possible.

Requirements:

- M.S. or Ph.D. degree in statistics or related fields
- Confident in trial design, survival analysis and mixed models
- Familiar with SAS and S-Plus (or R)
- Comfortable for team work
- Good communication skills, especially with non statisticians
- Project management skills
- Fluent in English speaking and writing
- Knowledge in German or French would be advantageous
- Preferably with working experience in design, tracking and analysis of phase I-III clinical trials
- Experience in microarray data analysis would be advantageous

Main tasks:

- Ensure appropriate statistical planning, analysis and reporting of clinical studies and associated research projects (e.g. translational research, quality of life, outcome research, health economy, etc.)
- Manage publication of study results
- Represent the Statistics Unit in the Trial Teams and attend meetings with physicians to discuss project requirements
- Initiate and perform methodological research in medical statistics when appropriate and needed
