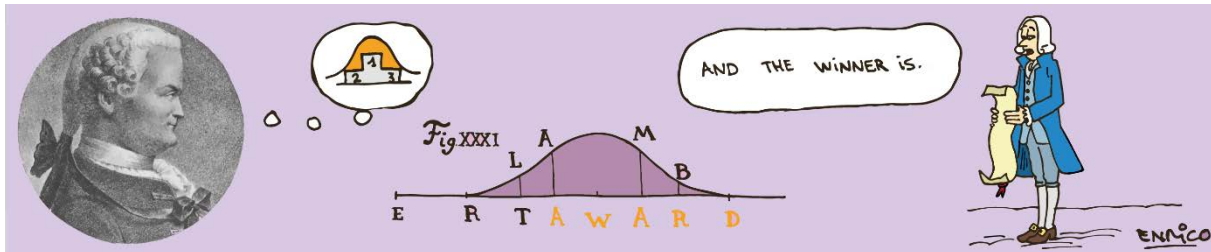


Lambert Award for Young Statisticians 2018



The Swiss Statistical Society (SSS) has established since 2013 the Johann Heinrich Lambert Award to recognise the work of young statisticians. The Lambert Award consists of a certificate and 1000 Swiss Francs. It entitles to a plenary talk at the Swiss Statistics Meeting in 2018 in Zurich.

Young statisticians (up to age 35) are invited to submit their work to the Jury of the Lambert Award before **30th April 2018**. The Jury is composed of the following 5 members:
